The team is representing Bezeq in an appeal against the competition authority's decision that the telecoms company abused its dominance when it set its pricing policy for internet and telephone infrastructure services.

In merger control, the firm is acting for Google in its acquisition of Elastifile, a developer and provider of cloud-based file storage software and services. It represented science and technology conglomerate Danaher in its acquisition of Biopharma, which develops tools for researching and developing biopharmaceutical drugs. It also acted for General Electric subsidiary Baker Hughes in the establishment of a joint venture with GE to supply, service and develop aero-derivative gas turbine engines.
